The church has been open for private worship since July 4th – which continues other than 3 days following each Sunday Service (Diocesan Guidelines)

Shortly after that date, on 15th September, was Revd Mark Cannon's last Service in this parish and we thanked him for 10 years in the Benefice, and gave him gifts from us.

Tatham Parish Council hopes that this finds you well and that you are managing to carry on as best you can during these challenging times.

The Parish Council met remotely on 29th September 2020 via Zoom. The draft minutes from this meeting are available on the Documents page of the Parish Council Website (or click on the link - [Minutes Sep 2020](#)). These will

The Parish Council appreciates that some parishioners are unable to join remote meetings to discuss matters of concern or interest to them. We will therefore try to resume face to face meetings as soon as it is safe to do so, in accordance with Government and the National Association of Local Councils guidance.

Governance Documents – The Parish Council is required to review its Governance Documents every two years. Climate Emergency Review of the Local Plan 2020-2031 – Lancaster City Council (LCC) formally adopted its local plan in July 2020 but it was too far advanced to properly consider the declared climate emergency in January 2019. LCC has therefore started an immediate Local Plan review to ensure aspects of the Climate Emergency are reviewed and included. Lowgill Telephone Box – BT sent a contractor to paint the Lowgill telephone box during September and we hope you have noticed that it is now back to its traditional bright red.

Wild Flower Verges - Approximately 20 years ago Lancashire County Council designated the verges from the Tatham Bus Shelter to the Clearbeck Bridge on Long Lane as a wild flower protected area. They installed notices to prevent random cutting during the flowering season but these signs are no longer visible. There was no cutting this year due to Covid 19 and for many previous years they were erroneously cut. However, the flowers continued to bloom and have been enjoyed by those who knew where to look for them. In October, after the seeds had ripened and fallen, the Parish Council asked our Lengthsman, Catherine Halstead, to cut the herbage short and it was subsequently removed, so that next year's blooms will benefit. We hope parishioners will look out for the flowers when passing the verges in 2021 and enjoy them.

National Community Lottery Fund Grant for Lune Valley Swimming Pool.

Exciting news -. We have been awarded a significant grant of almost £30,000 from the National Lottery Community Fund. This will greatly assist with alleviating the additional costs incurred with both the shutdown period and

the subsequent running of the pool under the current Covid19 restrictions designed to ensure your comfort and safety.

We will also use the National Lottery Community Fund grant to offer subsidised family swimming opportunities for the local community and we are planning to work with local GP surgeries to offer subsidised rehabilitation and remedial swimming opportunities. In addition this grant will allow us to replace the ageing boiler and install CCTV in the reception and office/admin areas. We are very pleased to report that as we celebrate our 2nd anniversary of re-opening of the pool it continues to be extremely well supported by the local community. Despite the necessary Covid 19 restrictions the response has been very encouraging. Thank you so much to all our supporters, staff, 'pledgers' donators and community volunteers.

This is all very good news at what has been a turbulent time. At the end of 2019 there was an existential threat from accrued debts and operating losses but the combination of this grant and efforts by our team to reduce operating losses means that we can now say with some confidence that, all things being equal, the immediate future of the pool is guaranteed. While there is no room for complacency, we can continue to provide a safe environment for leisure and exercise and maintain local employment opportunities.

We hope you will come along and swim with us in the near future. Please remember to book in advance because numbers are limited and some sessions are over-subscribed. Please check our website for the revised operating guidelines and the new timetables. Above all enjoy your pool.
