## **Flu Vaccinations 2020**

**Starting 26<sup>th</sup> September 2020**

**Due to the need for social distancing this year:**

**All vaccinations will be done by appointment only**

**We have no drop in clinics – Please book a time slot online, via the app or via reception.**

### **Bentham Surgery**

**There will be 4 Saturday clinics: Starting 26<sup>th</sup> September for 4 weeks. All will be between 9.00am and 12 noon.**

**There will also be 4 Wednesday evening clinics: Starting 30<sup>th</sup> September for 4 weeks. All will be between 5.00pm and 7.00pm.**

### **Ingleton Surgery**

**Every weekday between 10.00am and 12 noon from 28<sup>th</sup> September for 4 weeks.**

We offer flu vaccinations to all patients aged 65 and over, plus those considered 'at risk'. This includes patients with the following conditions:

**Heart Disease, Diabetes, COPD. Chronic Kidney Disease, Obesity, Asthma (those only on daily treatment), Chronic Liver Disease, Pregnant women, plus at risk children and all children born between 1/9/2016 and 31/8/2018**

Patients in the new 50 – 64 cohort are going to be targeted from November

with NHS England saying this would only be introduced when they are confident of sufficient vaccine supplies.

### **Tatham Parish Council News**

Tatham Parish Council hopes that this finds you well and that you have been able to enjoy the recent longer days and warm weather, allowing you some opportunities to meet up with friends and family.

The Parish Council met remotely again on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2020 via Zoom. The draft minutes from this meeting are available on the Parish Council Website ([www.tathamparishcouncil.org.uk/2020-21/](http://www.tathamparishcouncil.org.uk/2020-21/)). These will be ratified by the Parish Council at the next Meeting on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

Following the resignation of Cllr Mason as a Parish Councillor in early May, the Parish Council implemented its Co-option Policy and are pleased to announce that Ben Ray was co-opted at the July meeting, to become our seventh Parish Councillor.

The September meeting is also to be held remotely and the agenda will be available on the Parish Council website from Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2020.

The public and parishioners are welcome to join the video meeting via their smartphones or laptop/PC or, with audio only, via an ordinary phone. Each Parish Council meeting provides an opportunity for 'Public Time'. This enables members of the public to raise any issues or concerns directly with the Parish Council. Please contact the Clerk ([clerk@tathamparishcouncil.org.uk](mailto:clerk@tathamparishcouncil.org.uk)) to obtain the joining instructions if you wish to join the September meeting.

The Parish Council appreciate that some parishioners are unable to join remote meetings to discuss matters of concern or interest to them. We will therefore try to resume face to face meetings as soon as it is safe to do so, in accordance with Government and the National Association of Local Councils guidance.

### Local Planning Applications

The local Planning Authority for Tatham Parish is Lancaster City Council (LCC). LCC have a statutory duty to consult residents on planning matters and can do this by sending out letters to neighbours or by posting a site notice in the vicinity of a proposal. The level of notification is often dependent on the type of proposal and some householder development can be undertaken without the need for planning permission. The Parish Council is invited by LCC to comment upon all planning applications which LCC receive that are located within Tatham Parish and occasionally, where it might affect Tatham residents, those in neighbouring parishes. The Parish Council endeavours to respond to all applications it receives and will select one of the three available response classifications when it does – Object, Support or Neutral. ### A message from Phil Mugford. Chair of Lune Valley Community Society Ltd./Lune Valley Swimming Pool

Following enforced shutdown of all swimming pools in the UK, permission was given to re-open in August. We decided to hold off until August 24<sup>th</sup> in order to provide the safest possible environment and guarantee the financial viability of the pool.

It is clear that when we open swimming will not be the same in the immediate future as it was. All sessions must be booked in advance and new procedures will be in place. All are on our website and Facebook page, please read this before booking. The rules are designed to make your swim as enjoyable as possible and most importantly – safe!

There will be a reduced timetable from 24<sup>th</sup> August and a full programme from 31<sup>st</sup> when we welcome back our school partners. The new guidelines reduce the volume of swimmers we can have in the pool at any one time to ensure social distancing. This is all on the website and Facebook page and if you can't find a slot for your particular requirements let us know and we will try to assist

All this places pressure on the finances of the pool and although we have been successful in stabilising the finances since the new Trustee team took over at the end of 2019, the Covid-19 hiatus hit us just as we were building momentum. There are some historic debts to overcome but the pool will be viable going forward. This is thanks to the support we have had from Lune valley communities, while the trustees, volunteers and staff have all pulled together to ensure that we will come back stronger than ever.

As always we are focusing on making sure that swimming continues to be available for all, please check out our website and the revised operating guidelines and timetables, as well as a very special offer for families. Above all come back and enjoy your pool again.
